1. Summarize the events that take place in Acts 3.

2. According to Acts 3:1, what were Peter & John doing? Do you think this was a regular occurrence?

3. What do you learn about the lame man in verse 2?

4. With What power did Peter preform the miracle?

5. What was the Man's response upon being healed?

6. What was the reaction of the people who witnessed the miracle?

7. What did Peter then do?

8. According to verses 11-16, where did the credit for the miracle lie?

9. What did Peter say is the result of genuine repentance(verses 19-21?) Compare this to Chronicles 7:14.

10. How are the events in this chapter similar to and different from those in Acts 2?
